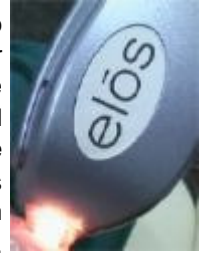

How does it work? The unique **elōs™** combination of light and radio frequency (RF) energies provides controlled selective thermolysis to vascular lesions including telangiectasias and leg veins up to 4mm in diameter. The applicator also includes built-in contact cooling which ensures additional epidermal protection and comfort for the patient. Bi-Polar RF is controllable and predictable. The Bi-Polar Radio Frequency of **elōs™** technology flows between the two electrodes of the application head, delivering maximum targeted energy to the treatment area. **elōs™** can improve unsightly leg veins, facial spider veins and other unwanted vascular lesions. Spider veins and larger blue-green vessels on legs will gradually fade.



Who can be treated with elōs™? Anyone with unwanted leg veins or vascular lesions may be a candidate for treatment with **elōs™**. What is Rosacea, Melasma, Telangiectasias and their optional treatments?

What is Rosacea? Rosacea is an unidentified chronic hereditary condition usually seen on facial skin, mostly seen in the early 20s, but usually does not start unless the ages of 30-60. The early stage rosacea is characterized by persistent redness and telangiectasias (spider veins) normally seen on the cheeks frequently followed by bumps (medically known as 'papules') and pus containing bumps (medically known as 'papulopustules'). Most commonly seen in fair-skinned individuals, rosacea affects more women than men; though men normally suffer from a more severe case of rosacea.




Can Rosacea be treated? Control of your Rosacea flare-ups is very important. If treated in the earlier stages with **Fotofacials** and a product such as the **Vivier Pharma Anti-Redness daily moisturizer** (available at Permalaser), you have better success in keeping it under control. As we age, rosacea normally is more difficult to treat due to the worsening conditions.

 **What is Melasma?** Melasma is also known as chloasma or the mask of pregnancy. It is not a harmful disease, but can severely affect a person's cosmetic appearance. Melasma is skin discoloration (tan, brown, blue or black, dark brown to a deep grey) found most commonly on sun-exposed areas of the face. Sun exposure is said to be the biggest culprit. In the summer, melasma tends to darken after exposure to the sun, fading in winter when the sun is not as harsh. Melanin absorbs the energy of the sun's rays in order to protect the skin, tanning occurs as a result, causing dark areas to get even darker.

What are the treatment options? It is best to begin treatment at the first sign of melasma in order to have the best chance of preventing and treating it. The key to preventing melasma is sun avoidance and daily sunscreen use. However, for most of us, it is too late for prevention, and there are a number of treatment options available. Fortunately, there are some very effective treatments that will help even the skin tone more rapidly such as **bleaching creams**, **chemical peels** and **IPL Fotofacials**. Left alone, and not intensified by sun exposure, melasma tends to stay around for less than a year. Impacted skin cells with the discoloration are "surface" cells, and melasma becomes "permanent" if the discolored area splits, allowing these hyper-pigmented cells to go deeper into the skin layers. When the discolored cells with melasma are settled within your deeper dermal tissue levels, they resist conventional treatments.

Also note that a patient presenting themselves with an Aspirin (salicylate) allergy cannot have a peel. Be aware of the health of your skin is a major responsibility. Try to avoid drying your skin out, as well as over moisturizing it. It is a good rule of thumb to avoid sun exposure, but to use sunscreen daily with at least a **SPF 30** while taking in the appropriate precautions to counter the sun's rays, ensuring both your inside health and outside appearance are as well as they can be.

 **What are Telangiectasias?** Telangiectasia (Pronounced: te-lan-jee-ek-taa-zsha) are dilated superficial blood vessels, which can occur in rosacea. Telangiectasia can also be found in inherited disorders or due to long term use of topical fluorinated corticosteroids; but most of the cases are of an unknown cause. You can tell if you have telangiectasias. Small, unsightly red, purple or blue blood vessels can be found along the surface of the face, upper chest and neck. On occasion, they can be found on other parts of the body, including the ones found of the legs (called spider veins).

How can I get rid of telangiectasias? These blood vessels are not abnormal and serve no particular purpose, therefore removal of these broken vessels with **spider vein removal with elōs™** providing us with a pleasing cosmetic appearance.
